

The film begins with the camera focused on a snowcovered expanse - a flat, abstraction - then it presents the park's trees — a three-dimensional composition.

"Damnation of Faust: Evocation," 1983, by Dara Birnbaum

Featured in Art in Motion, Miami

Evocation is the prologue of the three-part series Damnation of Faust, a piece shot in the streets of lower Manhattan, Birnbaum transforms the well-known Faustian myth into a dreamlike introspection. The artist juxtaposes the past with the present and memory with reality glimpses of meaning are revealed like a fan being shut
